



Year One Summer Term Week 7

Topic: Enchanted Woodlands



We hope you all had a restful half term and are excited to be back at school. We are in our final half term of Year 1 with lots of exciting learning happening. Our topic for this half term is Enchanted Woodlands. As the 'Engage' for our new topic we are so excited to go on our trip to Hatchlands Park where we will be exploring a magical enchanted woodland.

Over the next two weeks we will be exploring the story *Little Red Riding Hood* as an introduction to our exciting new topic, Enchanted Woodlands.

To begin our exploration of the story we will become familiar with the different parts, the characters and the setting. We will use this information to help us understand why this book is set in an enchanted woodland.

Later in the week we are going to re-write the story using Pie Corbett's Talk for Write technique. This is where words that are repeated often get a specific action and symbol allowing the children to become very familiar with the vocabulary and structure of the story.

Please ask your children to retell the story at home, encouraging them to use the actions.

This week we will be reviewing and progressing our knowledge of place value. We will be looking at how many hundreds, tens and ones are in a number and how this can help us to write it correctly and understand that the answer must be bigger or smaller according to what the number sentence is.

We will be focusing on ensuring that each child is writing their numbers correctly and that they can count to 100. We will then compound this knowledge by counting backwards from 100 and identifying patterns in our 100 squares when we count in 10s, 5s etc. If you are aware that your child finds double digit numbers tricky then please practise these where possible.

Foundation Subjects



Our focus for RE is still Hinduism and we will be looking at the Raksha Banhan festival and what it means to Hindus. During P.S.H.E. we will be focusing on what being proud means and what makes us feel proud.

In P.E. children have been enjoying Tennis and will continue to learn skills that they can apply. The children will continue to learn P.E. core skills such as, coordination and fluency. In I.C.T. the children will continue to consider what being safe online means. During curriculum the children will be doing DT and we will learn what type of animals live in a woodland, so that we can make them. If you get the opportunity to visit a library or travel to a woodland to discover what animals live in a woodland, it would be lovely for the children to share what they have found with their class.
