


# Year One Summer Term Week 9

## Topic: Enchanted Woodlands

The children will now have topic words added to their spelling lists. During last week we discussed using the internet safely. We showed the video 'Lee and Kim's Animal Adventure' which can be found on YouTube. This video highlights the importance of not trusting the other internet users that one may talk to through gaming. We discussed not sharing any personal information with these people no matter who they say they are and to inform an adult if they ever feel worried.

### English



After a fantastic trip to Hatchlands Park we will be using these memories to inspire our writing this week.

First we will look at all the lovely photos from the day. We will label the photos, write captions for them and discuss what is happening in them. Next we will create a 'planning map'. The planning will help us to focus on what our favourite parts of the day was and what happened at the beginning and the end of the day. Our 'planning maps' will include drawings, labels and brief sentences. Later in the week we will use these 'planning maps' to write recounts of our trip. When writing the recount we will start expecting to see children leaving a line between each paragraph to clearly show beginning, middle and end. We also continue to have high expectations for use of phonics, spaces between words and full stops used correctly.

### Maths



This week we will be focusing on compounding the children's knowledge of time. They will be reading and showing time to the hour, quarter and half past the hour. For those children who would like more of a challenge they will also be identifying quarter to the hour. The main focus will be on analogue clocks but due to the mass usage of smart devices we shall encourage them to convert these into digital times. Please bring your children's attention to the times that they use in their routine if you don't already.

### Foundation Subjects



During R.E. we will be comparing special stories that we have heard, to Hindu ones considering why they are important to us. In P.S.H.E. we will be thinking about the importance of community and what it means to be part of the community. During P.E. the children are continuing to develop throwing skills, to move their bodies in different shapes strengthening their control and coordination. The children will continue to learn P.E. core skills such as, coordination and fluency. In I.C.T. the children will continue to consider what being safe online means where the focus will be about personal information. In Geography the children will be learning about maps. They will learn to identify human and physical features of our environment and begin to identify and describe where places are through the use of simple map drawings. In Music the children will be focusing on using pitch and intensity to show a beginning, middle and end of a song with instruments.
