

Beddington Infant and Nursery School Site



One of the things that surprises families most when they visit is that the school and site is much larger than they had expected. We are tucked away behind trees which is to our advantage, however, it is a large site with three buildings.

The first building you come to is the main building with the office. All visitors report to the school office (the green building at the front of the school) and then through the security door into the school.

The **main building** houses the oldest children in **Years 1 and 2**.

The next building is the **Nursery** with its own large garden.

Finally, the **Reception** building is at the rear of the site, with its own outside areas.

We have **2 large grassed areas** and a **large hard-surface playground**. These areas are shared by all year groups.

We have an abundance of beautiful trees across the site which offer shade in the Summer and a beautiful backdrop all year round.



The large grassed area by Reception includes a Trim Trail and a new climbing frame bought by our families through the PTA Beddington Buddies.



This grassed area backs onto allotment land so is very peaceful.



The Reception building is at the rear of the site with a large hard-surface playground between the main building and the Reception building.
