# 'Bright Lights, Big City'

| Weeks 15 <b>Express</b> Speaking and Listening Focus  |   |

| <b>Express</b><br>  | <p>The children will share their learning with their link class. They will share what they have learned this term about London both in the past and the present, particularly about The Great Fire of London. The children will use their art skills to make Christmas cards and decorations.</p>   |
| <b>English</b><br>  | <p>Through daily phonic sessions the children will develop their skills to enable them to spell increasingly complex words. The children will develop their speaking and listening skills through sharing each other's learning and asking each other questions about what they have learnt. The children will also use their writing skills to write about their learning this term.</p> |
| <b>Maths</b><br>  | <p>Number – The children will review their knowledge of multiples and number bonds. They will apply their mental skills to solve problems. They will review their knowledge of place value and different ways to represent numbers.</p>   |
| <b>Religious Education</b><br>                                       | <p>The children will share and discuss The Christmas Story, retelling it in their own words. The children will review how Christmas is celebrated by families. We will also discuss how we celebrate Christmas at school.</p>   |
| <b>Personal, Social, Health and Citizenship Education (PSHCE)</b><br> | <p>The children will consider who they help both at school and at home. They will also think about how else they could help in the school community.</p>  |
| <b>Music</b><br>  | <p>The children will review their learning this half term, evaluating the Year 2 performance. They will sing and take part in singing carols as a Year Group.</p>   |
| <b>Wanted!</b><br>  | <p>Please save boxes over the holiday, for junk modelling in January. Cereal boxes are ideal, along with a selection of smaller boxes to join to the cereal boxes. When the boxes come into school, they will be left 72 hours before we use them.</p>  |
