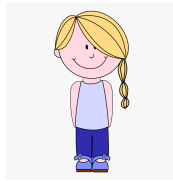

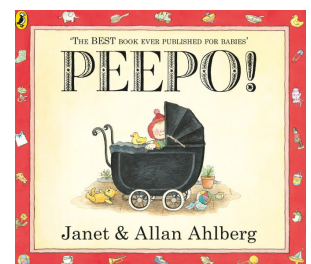
At home you can..

Maths









Next week we will explore patterns. We will create patterns with our bodies. For example, stamp, clap, stamp, clap. We will draw repeating patterns using 2D shapes.
