The children have been learning prepositional language such as 'on, in under, next to' over the last two weeks and have enjoyed using this language whilst playing games. We hope you have had fun doing the same at home!

Curriculum



We start to learn about Christmas and why it is celebrated. This goes hand in hand with learning the songs for our Christmas play. So, the sounds of Christmas may be heard a little early at home this year!

Literacy Communication and Language



We will read the Nativity story, learn the words to the songs and practise our lines or stage positions for the play.

We will continue with our daily Write Dance activities, strengthening our muscles readying us for holding pens and pencils and beginning to write

Maths



We will continue to think about positional language such as on, in, under, next to. This week the children will take charge of using the language and hiding objects around the classroom and garden and challenging their friends to find them.

Physical Development



Development of ongoing skills such as:

Go up steps & stairs, or climb up apparatus, using alternate feet
Use one handed tools & equipment, e.g. making snips in paper with scissors
Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils
Continue to develop their movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes & bikes) & ball skills.
