Curriculum	We will of course be focused on the Christmas story and we will use our show to remember all the different people involved in the Nativity. We will also explore how people celebrate Christmas with different traditions all around the world.
Literacy Communication and Language	We will practise retelling the Christmas story out loud. We will practise writing the letters in our names.
Maths	We will learn some Christmas counting songs and practise our one-to-one counting skills and numeral recognition as we sing.
Physical Development	<u>Development of ongoing skills such as:</u> Go up steps & stairs, or climb up apparatus, using alternate feet Use one handed tools & equipment, e.g. making snips in paper with scissors Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils Continue to develop their movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes & bikes) & ball skills.
