Curriculum



We will take a winter walk around the school grounds looking at all the signs of winter we can see, and thinking about the differences since our autumn walk.

Literacy Communication and Language



We will read **The Gingerbread Man** joining in with repeated phrases and counting and clapping the syllables in chosen words i.e. gin - ger - bread (3 claps) lit - tle - old - wo - man (5 claps)

Phonics



We will continue with our book Nature Shapes, this time we will use our phonics ears when we go on our winter walk and think about what sounds we can hear in the environment.



Maths



We will create 2D shape pictures using pasta, twigs, shells etc. We will name the shapes we make and check the number of corners and edges.

Physical Development



<u>Development of ongoing skills such as:</u>

- Match their developing physical skills to tasks and activities in the setting. E.g. they decide whether to crawl, walk or run across a plank, depending on its length & width
- Skip, hop, stand on one leg & hold a pose for a game like musical statues
- Remember sequences and patterns of movements which are related to music and rhythm
- Be increasingly independent in meeting their own care needs e.g. brushing teeth, using the toilet, washing & drying their hands thoroughly
- Start to eat independently and learning how to use a knife & fork
