Next week we will begin learning about Lunar New Year. We will look at ancient artwork and will discuss what the past means. We will even have a go at writing with a quill.

In music we are learning the song 'Five Little Penguins'. We will play instruments in time to the music.

English Communication and Language



Next week we will be reading and exploring the Chinese Lunar New Year Story. We will be reading 'The Great Race' and learning about the different animals each year is named after. Our focus will be on describing the features of the animals in 'The Great Race' using our communication and language skills.



At home you can.....

- Describe the features of animals seen in your community

Next week our focus will be on one more and one less. We will focus on numbers to 10 and use objects to support our learning. We will identify one more/one less and write the matching number sentence.



At home you can.....

- practise writing numerals
- sing 5 currant buns and discuss taking one away each time someone buys a bun.
 - practise writing a number sentence (5+1=6)
