Which crayon is longer?






At home you can.....

Today your child has received a new Maths game to play at home. This is to promote a love for Maths and to practise key skills in a practical way.


Games are handed out every **Friday.** *Games must be returned on Wednesday*. We cannot give your child a new game unless they return their previous game.


Small Schools Challenge
