Next week we will be exploring number bonds to 10. A number bond to 10 is a pair of numbers that always add together to make 10. We will be using objects to help us develop our understanding of what amounts can be added together to make 10. We will be writing number sentences and we will practise forming our numerals.


0+10=10	4+6=10 00000	8+2=10
