

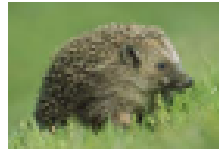

English Communication and Language

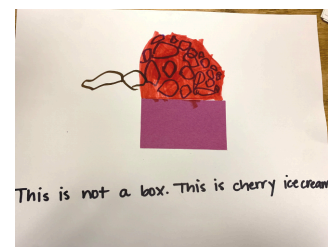


Next week we will be reading 'Not a Box'. We will be designing our own boxes and using our imagination to find new ways to use a box.

Maths



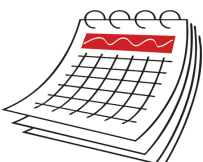

Don't forget to re-read books in your child's library. Re-reading books is great to develop fluency when reading. This encourages children to read by sight instead of sounding out.



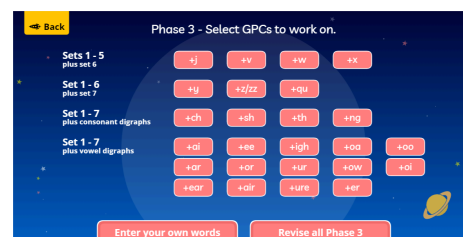
Eco Schools- Biodiversity
