

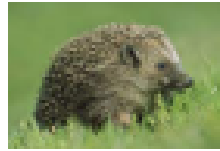

English Communication and Language

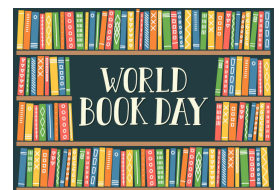
