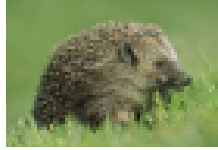

Curriculum



At home you can.....
