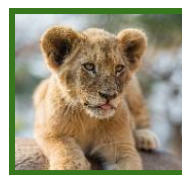
Growth and Creatures

Curriculum

Literacy Communication and Language

We will revise all the individual letters we have learned so far this term (s a t p i) as well as playing a range of sound games.

Maths



We will explore different types of measuring including volume, experiencing full, half full and empty.

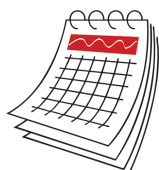
Physical Development



Development of ongoing skills such as:

- Start taking part in some group activities which they make up themselves, or in teams
- Choose the right resources to carry out their own plan. E.g. choosing a spade to enlarge a small hole they dug with a trowel
- Collaborate with others to manage large items, such as moving a long plank safely, carrying large hollow blocks
- Make healthy choices about food, drink, activity & tooth brushing
