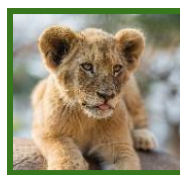
Growth and Creatures

Curriculum



We will recall everything we learned about the caterpillars and create a special book to record the stages of development.

Literacy Communication and Language

Phonics



We will remind ourselves of all the sounds we have learned so far - **s a t p i** as well as return to some of our favourite sound games to get tuned into sounds again!

Maths



We will make comparisons between the toy animals in the vets. We will learn how to order them according to size, we will compare the length, weight and height of our toys.

Physical Development



Development of ongoing skills such as:

- Start taking part in some group activities which they make up themselves, or in teams
- Choose the right resources to carry out their own plan. E.g. choosing a spade to enlarge a small hole they dug with a trowel
- Collaborate with others to manage large items, such as moving a long plank safely, carrying large hollow blocks
- Make healthy choices about food, drink, activity & tooth brushing

Reminders



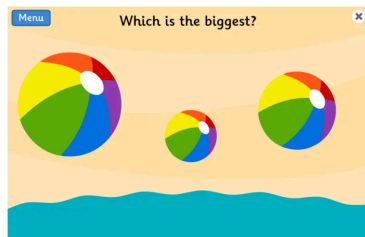
