Entrance through Beddington Infants' School – the gate will be opened by the Nursery classroom.


All children come to school in a Sports Kit. *Uniform must be brought to school in a bag.* We will change after Sports Day.

Next week we will continue to explore odd and even numbers. We will talk about the difference between odd and even numbers as well as sorting these numbers.




At home you can.....
