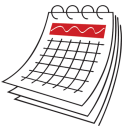

A very big welcome to all our new Nursery families!

This is our weekly newsletter that will provide you with an overview of future learning and events, including reminders and requests, as well as some suggestions for home learning.

Curriculum	We will be focusing on making friends, learning our friends' names and sharing our family photos at the front of our Learning Journeys. Please ensure you have returned the My Family sheets you were given at the home visit, if you have not done so already.
Literacy Communication and Language 	We will have a go at making marks with crayons, pencils and paints practising holding writing tools with a firm grip.
Maths 	We will be naming, sorting and matching colours.
Physical Development 	<u>Development of ongoing skills such as:</u> Go up steps & stairs, or climb up apparatus, using alternate feet Use one handed tools & equipment, e.g. making snips in paper with scissors Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils Continue to develop their movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes & bikes) & ball skills.
Dates for the term 	Thursday 9th October- Photographer taking individual photographs and sibling photos Thursday 23rd October - Opening Evening Friday 24th October - INSET day (school closed for children) Monday 27th to Friday 31st October - HALF TERM 11th - 14th November - Learning together sessions: Bear & Fox Cubs from 11.00-11.45am Lion & Fox Cubs from 2.45-3.30pm
Reminders 	Please make sure that your child has a spare clothes bag on their peg with the following NAMED items: tee shirt or polo shirt, joggers or leggings, pants or knickers, socks, shoes (plimsolls are fine as a spare) Remember we also need: a named sun hat, a named pair of wellies and waterproof trousers/puddle suit which will all stay at school. Bear Cub families: Doors are open from 11.35am for pick up, please be prompt as we MUST shut the doors at 11.45am so Fox Cubs can start their lunch.
