Curriculum	We will continue to find out about our new Nursery friends. We will play Nursery Bingo - a game which has all our faces on so we can practise learning each other's names.
	Please continue to return the My Family sheets you were given at the home visit so your child can show their page. If you do not have a printer please email photos to the school office for the attention of Mrs Towner.
Literacy Communication and Language	We will create pictures including cutting out images from cards and magazines.
Maths	We will begin to learn some number songs and start to recognise numerals as we sing them.
Physical Development	Development of ongoing skills such as: Go up steps & stairs, or climb up apparatus, using alternate feet Use one handed tools & equipment, e.g. making snips in paper with scissors Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils Continue to develop their movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes & bikes) & ball skills.

Please continue to help your child to practise pulling their knickers and pants down/up, whilst wearing their school uniform, so that they have greater success doing this on their own.
